

Preschool March: Jesus the True King

The Big Idea:

1. Children will understand that Jesus can do things that people cannot do.
2. Children will learn what Jesus did when He lived on this earth.
3. Children will learn that:
 - a. The Bible tells what Jesus did.
 - b. I can learn about God and Jesus from the Bible.
 - c. The people in the Bible were real people and the stories in the Bible are real.



Weekly Objective: Children will identify that Jesus loves all people and that Jesus wants all people to love Him.
