



Grade School March - Abraham

The Big Idea:

Kids will see that faith is possible because we have a God that we can trust.
Kids will understand that God always keeps his promises.
Kids will learn and see that for God nothing is impossible.
Kids will learn that faith in God is possible because of the Holy Spirit living in us.

Bible skills:

Kids will understand what "the Promise" is on God's Big Story Timeline.
Kids will learn which promises God made to Abraham and why they are important for us today.
Kids will be able to name the book of the Bible that contain the story of Abraham, Sarah, Lot, Ishmael, and Isaac and where the story fit on God's Big Story Timeline.

Scripture: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take." **Proverbs 3:5,6**

To Do at Home:

This month the children will learn more about Abraham. They will learn what it means to have faith in God. Abraham waited for more than 20 years for his promised son.

Share around the dinner table with each other stories of what God is doing in each person's life; at home, at school, at work. Stories of how great God is encourages us to have more faith. Abraham's story encourages us to have more faith. Encourage each other in how good and faithful God is.

Pray together for people in your life. Encourage each other to keep praying for the same situations. Even if we don't see answered prayers yet, we know that God is always faithful. Abraham waited for 20 years for his son to be born. Can we hold on to God's promises, knowing that we can trust God because He is faithful?
