Craig & Maureen Moody

We have been called to a 3-year term in **Cameroon, West Africa**. Each year we will be serving in a different capacity.

Year One: We have the privilege of being hostel parents to 9 kids who are from Korea, Congo/Cameroon, USA and Canada. These children all attend Rain Forest International School in Yaoundé, Cameroon. The parents of our hostel kids are pastors, linguistics workers, business people, and workers in unreached people groups. As we care for these children, the parents can continue the work God has called each of them to do.

Running a hostel is a vital ministry that gives Christian missionaries stationed throughout central Africa the alternative of giving their children a quality education, while keeping their children relatively close to them. It is also a ministry to the developmental needs of missionary kids who continue to look for answers to their questions about growing up, relationships, school, their future and their faith in Christ.

Year Two: Our second year, we will be moving 400 km north to Bamenda. Craig will be covering some of the responsibilities of Cal Hohn, our NAB Field Director, as he and his family will be on home assignment. Maureen will be using her nursing skills in teaching continuing education for medical workers.

Year Three: In 2017 we will be heading to Bamkikai, the home of the Life Abundant Program (LAP). This primary health care program will be our main ministry as Craig will assist in administration and Maureen will be involved in educating health workers.

Prayer Points

- Pray we would have wisdom, energy and enthusiasm for our work with the hostel kids.
- Pray for our hostel kids – some are struggling academically, and one is confused about what to believe about God.
- Pray we will be able to reconnect to our borehole and establish a reliable water supply. We have a temporary water source but it is costly.
- Pray we would find financial partners to bring our support to 100%.

Cameroon Mission Trip Information

This weekend, our Children's Pastor **Stephanie Grunau & Michelle Moody** (Bears paw Children's Director) are leaving with their team of Children's Ministry volunteers on a missions trip to Cameroon from January 3-18, 2016. The other members of the team are **Bennett Moody** and **Zach & Christina Ambrock**.

During their time in Cameroon they will be supporting **Craig & Maureen Moody**, RPC Missionaries (and Michelle & Bennett's parents!), and engaging in various projects while spending time getting to know the people and culture of Cameroon.

They will be working with local Cameroonian partner organizations to ensure all work is effective and sustainable for long-term benefits. The projects they will be participating in include:

- Planning & implementing sessions for missionary kids (1 years old – Grade 9) attending the CMF (Cameroon Missionary Fellowship) retreat
- Teaching Bible classes to more than 300 students attending the Nkwen Primary School in the city of Bamenda
- Serving at a primary school for deaf children by teaching a Bible class and facilitating an opportunity to work on fine motor skills
- Leading Chapel for a High School in the city of Bamenda including a worship time and preaching
- Teaching equipping sessions at churches for parents on the importance of family devotions and ways model your faith at home for your children

Prayer Points

- Please pray for the physical health of the team – that they would be protected while away and not miss serving opportunities due to illness
- Please pray that they would be able to develop meaningful relationships with the kids at CMF, as they will be spending a lot of time with them
- Please pray that the hearts of the Cameroonian kids they are connecting with would be softened and that as they share with them, the kids would understand the truth of God's love for them
