Unreached Peoples - The Task Remaining

*The RockPointe GO Team (Global Outreach) exists to educate, encourage and inspire all RockPointe attendees to pray, give and engage with our partners to reach ALL **unreached peoples** so that “His salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.” (Isaiah 49:6).*

God has had one purpose from the beginning of time. As God made it plain in the Abrahamic Covenant in Genesis 12:2-3 – **ALL peoples on earth will be blessed**. And then in Isaiah 11:9 – **the earth will be filled with people who know the Lord**. In Isaiah 49:6 God further says: *“It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the Gentiles so that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.”*

Our major focus in responding to both the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) and the Great Commandment (Luke 10:27) is helping to ensure that all people have opportunity to hear and respond to the good news of Jesus’ love for them.

Furthermore, God makes it clear that this ‘in gathering’ of the nations of the world would not be through a sovereign act of God carried out through heavenly beings, but rather carried out through a redeemed people – and people blessed by His redeemed chosen people. Then in the fullness of time, Christ came (Galatians 4:4) and the fulfillment of the promises became more evident – and the first fruits were gathered in. The next phase of ‘in gathering’ came with the blessing and power of the Holy Spirit on all God’s followers to proclaim the Good News in ever increasing circles of influence - from Jerusalem, to Judea, to Samaria, and then to all nations.

We pray, we give, we send and we engage with our global partners because we are concerned that there are still over 6,600 “unreached” or “least-reached” people groups (representing 3.12 million individuals) where there is still no viable Church capable of reaching them with the love of Jesus.
