



OPENING QUESTIONS

What have been some of the healthiest, most enjoyable relationships that you have had with someone? What made them so good? What qualities were present?

BIG IDEA

God is more.

READ TOGETHER

Read **Ephesians 3:20-21** together as a group.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Read Proverbs 3:18-20. What are some things that you just don't understand? Things that you long to understand or are actively asking God for wisdom for?
- 2) Just because you don't understand something doesn't necessarily make it less true, does it? Give some more examples of this: how quantum physics works, a combustion engine, how your spouse decides what to wear, etc.
- 3) Read Isaiah 55:8,9. God is incomprehensible. How does it feel when you say this? Do you think it is true? How does it affect the way you relate to God? What are aspects of God and walking with Him that are still a mystery to you? Are you comfortable with that mystery?
- 4) Read Ephesians 3:20-21. How much power do you think God has? How have you experienced His power in your life? What would it take for you to trust Him more?
- 5) Take a shot at defining the Trinity. What are key components of the definition? Discuss what you understand about the Trinity.
- 6) Read Deuteronomy 6:4-5. This states that God is one. How is this an important factor?
- 7) Read 2 Corinthians 13:14. We see all three Persons of the Trinity having a role in this blessing. How does the fact that the Trinity can have different roles speak of God's character?
- 8) Read Matthew 3:12-17. You see clearly how the Trinity relates to each other with intimacy and love. How is this instructive in our relationships? What is a practical outflow of this in our lives?
- 9) As you spend time thinking about your own relationships – how do you reflect the love and unity of the Trinity in your relationships? Start with family, then move to friends, and then move out to other relationships. What is the good you see in you and in others that reflects the image of God in your relationships?

PRAYER

Pray for each other to take the courageous step towards expressing His character and attributes in our relationships. Pray for the ability, desire and passion to be obedient to this and to follow through.

Then spend some time praying and asking God what relationships He is asking you to bring more unity and love in to. Share this with the group, and how you feel God directing you to do this.

CHALLENGE

We are reflections of God to a broken world. Go into this week expressing the character and quality of God in your relationships. Pray daily and ask God for help in this. That He would power your ability to do this. Is there a certain relationship he has called you to reflect His love and nature in more fully? Lean into that this week.
