- o Take a few moments and share about some your dinner table memories from your childhood. Are they mostly happy? Sad? Good? Painful? What kinds of table rules were there? Was there anyone not allowed at the table? What is your table like now? If you could be at the table with anyone, who would it be?
- o We jumped ahead in the story of David this weekend. Take some time to briefly review how he went from being a fugitive on the run to the established king of Israel. What key circumstances assured his place on the throne?
- o What is the significance of David inviting Mephibosheth to his table? Why is it such a powerful act of grace?
- o How do **you** define grace? What does it look like in your life? How has grace shaped your heart?
- o What do you sense the Holy Spirit asking you to pay attention to coming out of the story this week? Who could you invite to your table as an act of grace?
