Summary

We finished up our look at the life of David, specifically how God used this amazing but broken man, in his day, for God's purposes.

Read Together

Matthew 1:1-17 & Revelation 22:16.

Pause

Take some time to consider what has been read.

Discussion

- o Why is Jesus called the "son of David"? What is the significance of this? Why was his name attached to Jesus' genealogy?
- o Wade talked about Jesus' great desire to help us in our need and to walk with us in our brokenness. He calls to each of us, asking, "What do you want me to do for you"? Consider this in your own life. How would you respond to Jesus? Pray for one another in these responses.
- o Read Acts 13:36 – When you consider "serving the purposes God has for you, in your time"... what do you think of? What are the callings and passions that are on your life and heart? Pray for each other in these.
- o What has been a central learning or encouragement for you so far in this series on the life of David?
- o Finish up by praying for RPC – that we would be people who pursue God, work through brokenness and chase after healing, and that we would be people who wholeheartedly follow Jesus.
