OPENING QUESTION

Is there someone you know who was on mission for what they were doing?

READ TOGETHER

Acts 13

BIG IDEA

We are all called to be on mission with Christ, and He will give us the ability to influence many.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) What is your own mission in life? How did you discover it?
- 2) How was your mission confirmed in your life?
- 3) How has God communicated this vision to you?
- 4) Geoff quoted Phil Collins, a pastor from Kelowna saying: *“Some people know Jesus like a distant relative, instead of an intimate friend.”* How would you characterize your relationship with Jesus? How could you learn to hear his voice more and become more intimate with him? What are you going to do this next week?
- 5) We saw the amazing life change in the governor in Acts 13. How has the miracle of transformation taken place in your life?
- 6) How have you been a part of seeing this transformation in the life of someone else?
- 7) Who would you like to see this happen in? How could you start or pray more intensely about that? Could you set apart a day to fast and pray for that person and listen to what God would have you do for that person?

CHALLENGE

Paul and Barnabas gave a bold message about Jesus and how he fulfilled God’s plan for a saviour. How would you describe the Good News about Jesus to someone who didn’t know it? Please take a few minutes right now and practice this with each other.
