### Becky Matchullis

**Becky Matchullis** is a Family Resilience Coach serving with **Outreach Canada** to meet the needs of International Worker (IW) families around the world. She passionately coaches, debriefs, builds resources, and trains in order that IW's are supported to live from strength and resilience. Over the past 16 years she has helped hundreds of families through transition and crisis. She designed and for the last 17 years has directed the C&MA's MK and teen re-entry camp at Ambrose University.



Becky grew up as a missionary kid (MK) in Hong Kong and Malaysia. Later, she and Harvey were missionaries (IW's) with the Christian & Missionary Alliance in Indonesia, Cambodia and Kuwait. She has lived the life and brings wisdom and compassionate experience to her interactions with IW's. This year God called her to give up her business clients to invest full time in working with IW's. This is her passion!

Teaming up with Outreach Canada allows the building of prayer and financial support so that more IW families can be helped. 4 years ago, Becky collaborated in designing a Canadian college aged re-entry retreat for MK's, called "ReBoot". It provides a safe place for them to develop peer relationships, review their life stories, and find courage and tools to help them move into Canadian culture. Most MK's have spent less than a handful of years growing up in Canada. They are often alone while their families continue to serve abroad. Each year Becky is part of the teaching and coaching team for ReBoot.

For more than 45 years, **Samaritan's Purse** has aided victims of disaster, disease, poverty, famine, and war. We seek to follow the Biblical example of the Good Samaritan, who not only bandaged the wounds of the man left for dead but also helped him recover.



This year, we responded to a devastating earthquake in Ecuador and a fierce hurricane that pounded Haiti and the Bahamas. We're also working to meet the critical needs of refugees fleeing from terror and bloodshed in the Middle East and parts of Africa.

Our development projects around the world are building the capacity of indigenous churches to break the cycle of poverty and exploitation in their communities and share the hope of Jesus Christ to the least reached.

**Operation Christmas Child** provides an opportunity for people of all ages to be involved in a simple, hands-on project that focuses on the true meaning of Christmas - Jesus Christ - God's greatest gift. Each shoebox is filled by Canadians with hygiene items, school supplies, and toys, and is given to children regardless of gender, race, or religion.



Every item added to an Operation Christmas Child shoebox has the potential to impact a child. **#ShoebboxGiftStories** tell first-hand accounts of the life-changing impact of a gift delivered in Jesus' Name. **Last year, RockPointe Church packed nearly 900 shoeboxes for children around the world.**

When culturally appropriate, a book entitled ***The Greatest Gift***, which has been translated into 130 different languages, is offered to children *after* the shoeboxes have been distributed.

Local churches and ministry partners are equipped with a 12-lesson Bible study course, titled ***The Greatest Journey***, which introduces interested children to Jesus.



Since 2010, more than 373,000 local teachers have been trained to lead lessons and disciple children, and nearly 7.5 million children in over 100 countries have voluntarily enrolled in ***The Greatest Journey***. In 2015 alone, **more than 1.2 million children made decisions to follow Jesus.**
